Does anyone have a working configuration of Microsoft's implementation of NFS via Services for Unix 3.5? I have a Solaris 9 box that I try to mount a share on but get permission denied each time. I suspect the Unix username to Windows name mapping is the problem. The directory shares out fine from windows and the Solaris box sees it as seen below but I can't get access. I've followed the documentation and google'd a bit but my search has been fruitless to this point. The Windows box is an XP Professional system. If anyone has any useful documents or links on the matter, I would greatly appreciate it.
