I've patched our Tru64 5.1A machines to SSH 3.2.2 as recommended by the recent security bulletin from 3.2.1. Now people who use ssh and bring up X applications on their Linux terminals gets errors like:

```
/usr/bin/X11/xauth: (stdin):1: bad display name "6012" in "add" command
```

or

BAD

```
Error: couldn't connect to display "6013"
```

```
while
```

```
initializing application (Tcl_AppInit?)
```

or

```
Error: Can't open display: 6010
```

Does anyone have the same problem?
