It says it was already saved (as expected – as savecrash is being run at system startup)

Here is what tombstone says:

The Memory/IO Controller only observed the Broadcast Error. It did not log any additional information about the HPMC.

I installed this patch (said to improve crash image saving performance or something).
Now it recognizes every reboot as crash! It syncs disks, shuts the machine down, LCD displays state change – and then "Unexpected HPMC" message is shown and core is being saved.

Somebody is thinking the crash dump has not been saved.
Try clearing the dump flag (# savecrash -c) and see what happens when you reboot the system.
