- > *Other documentation says genucode files should be in the microcode bin file*
- > *I downloaded, but I only see these files: 40x.readme,*
- > *IBM_____CDRM00203.06.0 and dsdata.*

Genucode is available there, below the link for the 40x CDROM drive firmware update.

You can do the CD drive firmware update in 4.3.3 with genucode, no problem. Done that for about 40 systems. Doesn't take very long.
