Hi,

I have various problems..

First: IPv6

i disabled the ipv6 option in the GENERIC kernel but there are lot of application (like ftp) that make (4 or 5 times) ipv6 query to the dns server that

doesnt support ipv6 stack.

So that the connections are very very slow. So the question is how can I disable in the entire system the ipv6 support ?

Second: compat_linux

i have a statically app linux binary and i have enabled the linux compatibility

in the kernel and then enabled kern.emul.linux = 1

but the app doesnt work.. what should i do to run this app ?
