Depends on the app. If it's written using only libraries that are available on both systems, you may not have to change it. For any decent-sized real-world app, there's usually SOMETHING different that needs to be changed, though. How much varies widely by app and by system.

>the already compiled code will work

Nope. You'll almost certainly need to recompile even if you don't change code. The exception would be if you're using Java. But then you probably wouldn't be asking.

>if i port my application to Solaris.

The above work IS porting your application to Solaris.
