> *My main concern is regarding my ADSL modem, a simple USB BT voyager modem (not the 100 or 105 model, its just call the USB BT Voyager modem). I cant find out if it is supported and I cant seem to find any drivers for it, certainly not on the producers website.*

> *Will the modem work in Solaris? – or I am doomed to continue with XP (I cant afford to buy a broadband router)*

I notice Masayuki Murayama has added an axf driver to his list of drivers, which supports a USB to fast ethernet controller.

I've no idea if a USB DSL modem looks anything like a USB ethernet controller, but that might be worth a shot.
